Call for leading Team for the T2MED 2026 entrepreneurship hackathon

The Dean of the Faculty of Medicine invites you to lead a flagship event of the Faculty of Medicine that will take place for the 12th year.

The medical entrepreneurship hackathon is organized by students and for students and is intended to connect the Faculty of Medicine with the other faculties at the Technion, to create a fertile environment for medical innovation and is a unique experience for its participants.

The hackathon will be held on May 6-8, 2026, and will last 3 days.

During the event, the students will work in joint teams, will be helped by mentors from the fields of medicine, engineering and business and will participate in workshops and enrichment activities.

At the closing event, a competition will be held where the participants will present to the jury the projects they worked on during the hackathon.

The outstanding teams will win prizes, publicity and support in the further development of the project.

We are looking for an organizing team of medical students and the engineering and science faculties at the Technion, from all years, with an affinity for entrepreneurship to lead the Hackathon 2026!

The team will be responsible for planning, managing and executing the event, the role includes the following tasks:

- Planning and producing the event, including working with suppliers and budget management
- Recruiting participants and partners (including sponsors)
- Development of themes for the hackathon challenges
- Creating marketing communications
- Management and operation of the event

In the body of the email, you must state your full name, phone number, faculty/course of study and academic year, as well to attach for applying a personal motivation letter.

The students leading the organization of the conference will be able to choose one of the following options:

1. Students in the pre-clinical years or bachelor's/master's degree students from faculties other than medicine will receive financial compensation.
Graduate students who are receiving a scholarship will need to obtain an approval for employment from the Scholarships Department.
2. Students from the clinical years (medicine) will be able to choose to submit the Hackton as a thesis or receive financial compensation.
